6124.1

CURRICULUM GUIDES

- I. Guides or course syllabi will be established for all areas of the curriculum and shall be the basis for instruction in the Clark County School District. Members of the professional staff shall utilize these guides as a means of meeting the needs of individual students.
- II. The development of specific teaching techniques is the responsibility of the teacher. They are to be consistent with the district's objectives and proven principles of learning.
- III. Individualized education plans (IEP) identifying both long-term goals and short-term objectives shall be developed for each special education student and shall be the basis for instruction of students in the Clark County School District special education programs.
- IV. Special education teachers are to develop specific teaching techniques that are consistent with stated objectives as identified within the individualized educational plans of each special education student. Curriculum guide content may be adjusted to meet the individual needs of special education students. Proven principles of learning are to be maintained when making curricular and instructional adjustments.
